This moment calls on the MHAction community to come together and stand up for immigrant families that are being abused by the Trump Administration's immigration policy. MHAction's Core Team and staff believe that our country should be forging a path to be a welcoming place for those fleeing violence, oppression, and poverty. We are deeply outraged and saddened that instead the Trump Administration is turning its back on families seeking a better life and has cruelly chosen to separate or jail families indefinitely. Criminalizing immigrants and refugees is morally reprehensible and a dark atrocity that we cannot tolerate. In light of this grave situation in our country, we feel we must reflect on MHAction's mission and organizational values and take concerted action.

MHAction's mission is to engage and empower homeowners and residents who live in manufactured home communities to protect the viability and affordability of our communities and organize people across class, race, religion, age, citizenship status, sexual orientation, and gender to stand up for each other. The core values that drive our work together are compassion for our neighbors, love of our communities, and treating all people with dignity and respect.

We see our efforts to ensure that manufactured homeowners are treated with dignity and given a chance to thrive as being directly intertwined with the fight to ensure that immigrant families are welcomed with a fair and just immigration system. We draw our organizational strength from our diversity and believe our nation does as well. We implore our elected officials to keep families together and support just and humane immigration policies. Families belong in communities, not cages.
